PLEASE NOTE

Students must remain in the exam room for the **FIRST NINETY MINUTES** of the exam. **All exams are two hours (with the option of any student staying for 30 min extra) with the exception of NSE exams and IB exams.** If a time is specified beside an IB exam, that is the length for the time allowed exactly.

Once students have written their exam they should either leave the building or wait for bus time in the library or cafeteria. Students are not to be in the halls. Busses will arrive at 3:00 as usual.

Late Policy for Exams

Students who arrive late for an exam are to report directly to the office. Students who arrive beyond the 90 minute dismissal time will not be permitted to write their exam. All students are encouraged to be in their exam room 15 minutes PRIOR to the beginning of each exam as indicated on the exam timetable.

Medical Excuses

Medical excuses for having missed exams must be approved by the Administration on later than January 31st. Students who miss an exam, must provide a medical excuse in order to write a make-up exam.

Make-up Exams

Make-up exams will be scheduled for January 31st (afternoon) or February 2nd.

Parent Portal:

The Student Parent Portal will remain open throughout the year. However, the teacher comments, grades and Learner Profile will be disabled as of January 20th and remain that way until after the three term schools distribute term 2 report cards.



CEC EXAMINATION INFORMATION - JANUARY 2018

Teachers will let students know if their exam is an in-class exam or one that is written during the formal exam week.

IN-CLASS EXAMS - JANUARY 19TH- 24TH

These exams take place during period one only (8:50-10:30) and regular classes will follow for periods 2, 3 & 4.

If school closures (storm days) occur during the In-Class Exam period from Jan. 19th – 24th, Thursday, Jan. 25th, will be a Snow Day Make-up Day. For example: if schools are closed due to inclement weather on Friday, Jan. 19th, Day 4, then Monday will be Day 5, Tuesday Day 6, and Wednesday Day 7, and Thursday morning (Jan.25) would be the Day 4 that was missed. If there are no snow days during the In-Class Exams, Thursday, Jan. 25th will be a regular school day (Day 8) with regular classes being held.

There are to be NO assessments for students during the In-Class Exam Period, other than exams.

FORMAL EXAMS- JANUARY 26th – 31st

There are NO regular classes during our Formal Exam days. Students are only to attend school on the days they have a formal exam.

In the event of School Closure due to inclement weather between Jan. 26th to the 31st, all exams will be written the *following* school day. All exams would be moved ahead by one day and Second Semester would begin one day later.

Exam Conflicts

If you have an exam conflict (scheduled to write two exams at the same time), please report the conflict to Student Services. If you have an **approved exam exemption** in one of the courses, you do not need to report the conflict.

Exam Exemptions

All completed forms are due in the office by Friday, January 12th at 3:20 p.m. Any student who hands in a form after this date will not be eligible for an exam exemption.

First Semester Book Returns

Students are asked to return all textbooks, library books, and outstanding materials to their teachers as soon as possible after the examinations or test periods.

Second Semester Second semester will begin on February 2nd (tentative). Second semester schedules will be distributed in the morning.

Registration for 2018-2019 Current grade 10 and 11 students can anticipate registration activities for the 2018-2019 school year to begin in mid February.
