Students must remain in the exam room for the FIRST NINETY MINUTES of the exam.

All exams are two hours (with the option of any student staying for 30 min extra) with the exception of Provincial and IB exams.

<u>IB Exams</u>: There is NO Extra Time for Any IB Exams and IB Students Can NOT Leave Early. If a time is specified beside an IB exam, that is the length for the time allowed <u>exactly</u>. For example, IB MT11- students must stay for 2 hours, they cannot leave early, nor have extra time. This DOES NOT include Pre-IB classes/students, which are considered CEC courses.

<u>Medical Excuses</u> for having missed regular examination(s) must be approved by the Administration no later than June 25<sup>th</sup>, at 2 PM .

<u>Make-up Exams</u> will be scheduled for June 26<sup>th</sup> (with arrangements to be made by admin/classroom teacher).

Examinations in Single Section Courses will be written during the school days from Tuesday, June 12<sup>th</sup> (Day 2) to Monday, June 18<sup>th</sup> (Day 6). First period classes will be extended for In- Class Exams to 10:30 AM.

#### NOTE:

- The Student Parent Portal will remain open throughout the year. However, the teacher comments, grades and Learner Profile will be disabled as of June 6<sup>th</sup> until Report cards are distributed June 29<sup>th</sup>.
- Teachers who have a Formal Exam during the Exam Time Table, will not be testing/ quizzing
  after June 11<sup>th</sup>, except Grade 11 IB Classes. That week is reserved for in-class exams and final
  assessments for courses without exams. This will allow students to focus all efforts on their
  upcoming in-class exams, and CEC exams.

Achievement Awards have been established to give public recognition to students who have contributed to various aspects of student life at CEC.
